THEME: Urbanization and Public Health

Background

Japan Public Health Association has organized the First Meeting of Public Health Associations in Asia on 9 and 10, November in 1995, in which the activities of each Public Health Association were introduced and discussed. The Second Meeting was held on 9 and 10, March in 2000, in which the community health system in each country was introduced and discussed. The Third Meeting was held on 24 and 25, October in 2005, in which the health crisis management in each country was introduced and discussed. There three meetings were very meaningful and fruitful.

Theme

People all over the world tend to migrate and live in urban centers. Migration and immigration have an impact on social inequities in health. The globalization of markets, the seeking of higher education, increased use of communication and new information techniques are the driving forces behind the urbanizing process. Historically, urbanization has been a result of different processes, ranging from the effect of free market forces to political decisions, with vast consequences for large populations. Urbanization is commonly progressing in many countries, and there new types of serious problems occur, for example the environmental sanitation and environmental health problems, the lack of medical and health services, the lack of educational services and the maintenance works of infrastructures.

Many countries in Asia have achieved the economic development and the improvement of the health condition. However, recently they have encountered the many issues derived from "Urbanization." These issues include "urbanization and novel influenza," "urbanization and the prevention of the outbreak of infectious diseases," "urbanization and health crisis management," "urbanization and health promotion," "urbanization and the influence of global warming," "urbanization and environmental health," "urbanization and the sanitation of indoor environment of building and its management" and so on.

It is very important not only to exchange the information and the major issues derived from the urbanization, but also to examine, investigate and seek to settle the issues from the viewpoint of public health.
